





#### **Residential Transfers Fiscal Year 2023 YTD**







### Northwestern Lake Forest Hospital

- Construction Underway
  - New Parking Garage 800+ Spaces
  - Target Completion Spring 2024
- Pending Regulatory Approval:
  - 2 Additional Pavilions East Toward Route 41
  - Seeking Approval for 96 Additional Inpatient Beds (for a Total of 210)
  - New Emergency Department with Dedicated Entrance
- Target Completion Mid-2026


