


FY24 PROPOSED BUDGET*


City Wide Budget – all Funds Fiscal Year May 1 to April 30




City-Wide FY23 Expenses by Function (Amounts in Millions)



Residential Transfers Fiscal Year 2023 YTD





Deerpath Community Park Improvement Project




- Installation of synthetic turf athletic fields and additional community park amenities, including:
 - Two restroom buildings,
 - Renovated tennis/pickleball courts
 - Playground & Fitness stations, and
 - Natural area enhancements
- Construction: April through mid-October

Forest Park Bluff Stabilization

- Stabilization of remain bluff areas via the installation of retaining walls
- Also includes the installation of bluff wick drains and native drainage areas for stormwater runoff
- Project construction will occur after the beach closes (Labor Day) and will be completed prior to the beach reopening (Memorial Day)

Rockefeller Rd, McCormick Dr, Loch Ln Ravine Construction



- Project will address failed or failing City storm sewer infrastructure within these three ravine areas
- Features sustainability components such as native plant material
- Project construction to occur over the summer months, May – August

Northwestern Lake Forest Hospital

- Construction Underway
 - New Parking Garage 800+ Spaces
 - Target Completion Spring, 2024
- Pending Regulatory Approval:
 - 2 Additional Pavilions East Toward Route 41
 - Seeking Approval for 96 Additional Inpatient Beds (for a Total of 210)
 - New Emergency Department with Dedicated Entrance
- Target Completion Mid-2026


